SERMON

"Intentional Authentic Evangelism" Carlos Baladez

2 Cor. 4:7

"But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us." NIV

Three points to notice:

1) "We have." This phrase lets us know that we possess it now. We do not have to wait for some distant future nor is it something in the past. It is with us today!

2) What we have is a treasure in us now. This phrase, "Jars of Clay," is a euphemism pointing to our frail bodies. The same bodies that one day will return to dust. And what is this treasure? The previous verse lets us know that it is "the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ." This light is in us now! Here! Today!

3) Please take note that we are provided the reason why this treasure has been placed within us. We are told the purpose of having this gift placed within us is "to show." To show, what? To show that this all-surpassing power which is able to place "the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ" in us is from God and not from us. This power is the same power that raise Jesus from the dead unto life eternal. This power, is the power to convert a sinner into a saint. This power, is the power given to us to receive the life of the resurrected Christ. This power, is the power given us to allow Christ to shine his light to us, in us, through us, and beyond us. And why this light and power in us? Because God's glory is this -- God loves us!

Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again. Hallelujah!

Today, this Palm Sunday, let us laud and welcome our King and our Redeemer. Amen.
