You will see rare beasts, and have unique adventures."


And Jesus of Nazareth would simply, personally, directly, call and bid you: "Follow me!"

AN (almost) TRADITIONAL THREE-PART SERMON

THE FIRST STORY-TEXTS

I suggested, for our Wednesday digital Bible Study, that a "Dwelling in the Word" approach to the parallel narratives of this "calling and sending... greeting and serving..." Gospel story today's Matthew text and the similar-but-different version in Luke 10 — would be a fruitful introduction to...our lives as disciples in the weeks immediately after Powerful Pentecost and the following "Oh-My-It's-a-Trinity-Sort-of-God!" Sunday. Hold the texts side by side. Enjoy their reinforcing similarities. Ponder the differences. Need Wednesday's "stuff" re-sent? Just holler!

I've added some additional "texts" that also offer Gospel challenge and Gospel promise. What texts would you add: Biblical Echoes? Poetry? Autobiographical memories? Insightful friends? A Favorite Hymn or Anthem? God didn't stop speaking to us... when the canon of the Bible was closed. God has more to say than can be contained in just the 66 Books of the Bible.



(At least, not that I'm aware of!) It's just... in Biblical terms, "the fullness of time!" Thank you for the Ministry we've Shared!
