SERMON

Alive to God in Christ Jesus

(Larry Sears)

I found out Wednesday that Father's Day is this Sunday. This year is so messed up for me I can't even keep up with important dates. First of all, Happy Father's Day to all you dads.

Some of us have fathers that were not good role models in our lives. In looking back, we can say we know what a bad father was. It gives us a contrast to our heavenly Father, Who is good, and knows how to love us and all of His creation. For those who have loving fathers, it gives us a foundation to begin understanding God our Father, and His role in our lives.

With those thoughts in mind, let's take a look at one way God wants to show His love for us.

I have a Russian Bible that translates the Hebrew and Greek Testaments into Russian. John 1:1-3 is pretty close to the King James Version we are used to. ¹In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

² The same was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. ⁴ In him was life; and the life was the light of men. Verse 4 is a little different. The Russian translation says, In Him life was imprisoned. To be able to imprison or confine something requires that the container be bigger than that which is contained. Keep that thought in mind for a minute.

The disciples were talking to Jesus; struggling to understand everything He was telling them. The conversation is in John 14. Jesus makes this promise to them. "If you love me, keep my commands. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth. …you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. ²³ Jesus replied, "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching. My Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them." Now things get complicated.

A minute ago I said that to confine something, requires that the container be bigger than that which is contained. Jesus has just told the disciples that He, the Father, and the Spirit will be in them. This is definitely one of the BIG mysteries of God. He will make His home in us. Jesus prays for all believers in John 17. ²⁰ "My prayer is not for them (the disciples) alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me

through their message, ²¹ that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me. ²² I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one— ²³ I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

²⁵ "Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. ²⁶ I have made you led known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them."

What Jesus prayed was that the love of the Father for His only begotten Son is the same love the Father has for you and me. That love allows God to dwell in us and be with us. God loves YOU with the same love that He has for Jesus the Christ.

This is a short meditation today. Take some time to thank God for His blessings given in love. Think about what it means for God to dwell in us. He brings all His love and His gifts and freely gives them to us. What response will you give to this kind of unselfish giving?

As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Now remain in My love. (John 15:9)
