#### MESSAGE

"Who do you say Jesus is?" Matthew 16:15

Scholars tell us that Matthew was writing to a Jewish community. Can you imagine that? Picture the angst they must have experience. Do we stay with the law and continue trying to please God earning our salvation? Do we continue to approach God "the way we've always done it," or do we embrace this new way of grace? Can we now believe that God has done it all for us? After all, Jesus did cry out, "It is finished." Do we dare leave Moses and embrace this Jesus? Not even our "Princeton, Yale, and Harvard theologians" believe in him. His followers are rabble rousers and uneducated fishermen. And yet, how can Jesus accomplish such amazing feats if God is not with him?

In the midst of this controversy Jesus asks his disciples two simple questions. The first, "Who do people say I am? The second more direct and personal, "Who do you say that I am?" Impetuous, bold, and brazen Peter declares a revelation not his own, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." TNT made up of ten words given to him by the Father above. In essence, Peter is declaring Jesus to be God in the flesh, Immanuel. You, Jesus, are the savior of the world, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. You, Jesus, are the one who makes all things right between God and man, between creation and man, between man and himself. Jesus calls Peter "blessed," meaning happy.

The words of Jesus are as valid to us today as they were to Peter and his fellow disciples when Jesus first asked them. This blessing comes to us not when we parrot Peter's declaration but when we too receive this revelation from the Father above. We like Peter will be called "blessed," happy.

The opportunity is before us like the first century Jews to abandon trying to please the Lord and accept God's way of mercy and grace. Our days of trying to please God by keeping the law on our own strength will be over as we enter into the Rest of God wrought in and through Jesus. We will sing with the song writer, "All is well with my soul."

Come! Listen! Hear and Believe! In Jesus Christ we **are** forgiven. We **are** accepted. In the Beloved we **are** beloved. We **are** loved and valued. We are most blessed, happy, being His forever more! Amen
