MESSAGE

"Be"

Psalm 4610a "Be still, and know that I am God"

Hear ye the Word of the Lord afresh today. Let it speak to you. Engage it. Speak to it. Ask it questions. Allow it to challenge you, to inform you, and even to transform you. Old things have passed away, behold ALL things are made new. Words have meaning. Words have power. The writer of Proverbs says, "Death and life are in the power of the tongue." How much more the "tongue" of God?

When you were a child, did your mom ever tell you to behave? Probably. What did she mean? You were misbehaving? You were not acting right? You were out of

character? Yes to all of these, yet could it be that there is a deeper meaning to this message than first meets the eye?

Let me explain. My wife and I have four children. The godparents of one of our children were our guest for dinner one night. In conversation, my child's godfather said, "Do you know an easy way to see what a word means? Put the suffix in front of the root word." I tried it and it worked. Wonderful became full of wonder. Careful became full of care. Awful became full of awe (in the old sense of the word).

This little trick got me to thinking about the word "behave." Using the advice I just received, behave means to have being. I was misbehaving, therefore I was not having being. I ceased to be and became a do. I was doing what I was not supposed to do. I was acting in a way that was inconsistent with a person of being. My mother was not scolding me, which is what I thought when I was a child, yet now I see she was inviting me to return to a state of being.

I share this, because there are ways to hear a message as if for the first time. When I was first accepted into my doctoral program at Our Lady of the Lake University, a Sister welcomed us. During her welcome speech she shared with us the following. Psalm 46:10a, "Be still, and know that I am God." She instructed us to meditate on this verse in parts and listen for the Voice of God. She quoted the phrase in its entirety first. "Be still, and know that I am God." She then proceeded to instruct us to think, meditate, and contemplate on this verse like this:

"Be."

Then,

"Be still."

Then,

"Be still and know."

Then,

"Be still and know that I am."

And finally,

"Be still and know that I am God."

She then took us in reverse order until we were meditating once more on "Be."

I invite you to do this and write down your experience. Meditate on it again. Write down any new insights, and then share with others. Ask them to share with you. Our God is greater than anyone of us individually, and collectively for that matter. "For now all of us see through a glass, darkly." Perhaps in sharing, we can all see a bit more clearly, love him more dearly, walk with him as one, and BE!
