SERMON "Thank you, Lord!" Dr. Carlos Baladez

Psalm 118:1

As we look back on 2020 and look forward to 2021, let us shout, "Thank you, Lord!"

Yes, thank you Lord.

For he is good.

This goodness is expressed in his love for us.

This love for us endures forever!

Israel give witness to this God, to this Lord, to this goodness, and this Love.

The House of Aaron gives witness to the same.

We give witness to the same, too.

This witness turns personal in verse five.

I was in destress and called on the Lord. What happened?

The Lord answered me. He not only answered me, he placed me in a broad/spacious place. To be in a broad place implies a move. A move from the narrow to the broad. It is a move, a trip, a journey that the Lord initiates for us, accompanies us, and completes in and with us. A movement that takes us from here to there. It is to be delivered from a narrow, constricting, binding place or situation. It is to be taken out of self and placed into Him. It is to be taken out of the limited into the unlimited, out of the natural and into the supernatural, out of distress into the peace he gives which passes all understanding. This move that God designs takes us out of fear and into faith. Not a faith that we try to generate. No. His faith. His faith given to us, placed in us, operating in us through His Holy Spirit. To be in a broad place is to be taken out of bondage and the curse which sin brings and be placed into the Blessing. It is to be placed in Christ, abiding in Christ now and forever more!

At this point of my distress, I do not fear. Why? Because I now know that the Lord is on my side and not on the side of what was distressing me.

My distress, my fear turns to peace and faith. I come to realize, to personally experience that with the Lord on my side, I have no need, no reason to fear mortals. God trumps their obscene schemes and nefarious plans against me.

Realizing that the Lord is on my side to help me, I took courage and saw my situation in a different light. I saw in the light of the Lord. I saw things differently. I saw from the Lord's perspective and took noticed. My position of distressed turned to triumph! I was not the victim, but the victor!

With this new perspective, this new attitude, this new confidence and faith I agreed with the Lord and realized that it is better to take refuge in the Lord than to try to figure it out myself. I was unburdened of my self-righteousness, my self-effort, my government, my education, income... you get the point. The Lord God is infinitely better than anything this world can offer. God Almighty offers me himself.

He indeed has lifted me up and out of the miry clay and placed me upon the solid rock. That rock is Jesus! Immanuel has come. Immanuel is here. And, Emmanuel is for me. He is for you. He is for us. And in turn we are for him. Together we say, "Thank you, Lord!" Amen. To God be the glory, now and forever. Amen.
