SERMON

"*Remain"* John 15:4

Places. Places are like bellybuttons, we all have one. Where is your place to go to when things aren't going your way? Where is your place to "just get away from it all?" Maybe it's a mental place where you imagine your favorite setting doing your favorite activity sipping on your favorite drink. Or maybe it's a physical place where you walk to, drive to, or fly to in order to refresh yourself back to "normal," to regain your peace and your "center."

I recall, as a child I would love to be in the water whether it was at the beach, a river, a swimming pool, or an old fashion irrigation canal. Water was fun. It cooled me off. It made me lighter than I was and I could do things in the water that I could not do while on land. For example, stand on my hands, or float on my back while looking up at the night sky and seeing all the stars as pin pricks in the dark blue blanket above. Even today, water is one of my favorite places on earth. I could never get enough of being in the water. It is one place where I could stay and remain forever.

In today's passage, we see Jesus speaking to his disciples. This scene occurs just before his kangaroo court, conviction, and crucifixion.

Unfortunately, this passage has often been preached in a way to scare the heebiegeebies out of people or sending them to hell. It has been used as a scare tactic in an attempt to modify behavior. A, "you better or else," message and interpretation.

Allow me to suggest that this is not the case. A careful reading of this passage will allow you to see it as an invitation. Yes, an invitation to stay. To come. To belong. It is an invitation to make Jesus your favorite place to be. Or as the scriptures say, "to abide or to remain." To remain "in Christ," is a place where you can do things that you cannot do otherwise. Much like me not being able to do a handstand on Tierra Firme. Yet, even to this day I can do a handstand in the water.

You see, abiding or remaining in Jesus Christ, we experience things we cannot on our own, like new life. In Christ we experience eternal life, which is knowing God and Jesus intimately, personally, and eternally. Jesus is inviting us to stay, to remain in him. To live. To enjoy his presence, his power, and his personhood forever. To make him our preferred place to be. It's like a branch attached to the vine. It can only produce grapes as it remains attached to the vine, receiving its life-giving, life-producing sap.

Likewise, we too can only experience the Life of Christ being connected to Jesus, remaining in Jesus, staying connected to him by his Holy Spirit and his teachings. Only in Christ do we find forgiveness, pardon, acceptance, and everlasting joy.

Today, I invite you to join me and a whole cloud of witnesses and say, "Yes, Lord, by your grace we abide, stay, be, live, act, and remain in you forever more." Amen!
