SERMON "Come with me to a quiet place and get some rest." Larry Sears

The 6th chapter of Mark is full of activity. Jesus preached in His hometown. Amazing the people at first with the wisdom the Spirit gave Him and performing miracles. Then the people began to question His ability since they knew Him and His family. The chapter says Jesus was amazed at their lack of faith. I think one of the things that amazed Him was the people thought that since they knew Him and His family, God couldn't possibly work through Him. After all, He was just a carpenter.

Take a look around at each other. I know you see friends, family, and some that maybe you don't know. Realize that we are all children of God. We are all instruments that He will use to bring glory and honor to Himself – if we let Him.

Ephesians 2:11-22

Let us return to the 6th chapter of Mark. Jesus sends out the 12 disciples into the surrounding countryside. ¹² They went out and preached that people should repent. ¹³ They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.

Then Herod had John the Baptist beheaded.

Now we come to today's reading in Mark. The disciples were excited about what they had been able to do in the Name of Jesus. I'm sure their adrenalin level was high. They were doing the works that Jesus did! These fishermen, all around laborers, and even some highly educated men were used by God to bring our Father glory and honor. Not all the apostles were uneducated and poor. Matthew was a tax collector, so it can be assumed that he had to learn several languages that would have been used in the area where he worked. Luke was educated as a doctor.

Later in the chapter, 5,000 men get fed. The disciples head across the sea to Bethsaida struggling to row against a head wind. Jesus stays behind to dismiss the crowd, and then He goes up on a mountainside to pray. When He leaves the place where He was praying, He walks across the water and catches up to the disciples in the boat. The storm quiets down, and they arrive at Gennesaret.

That is a lot of activity. They had been so busy that they were worn out. They didn't even have time to eat. Jesus' request must have been music to their ears, "*Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.*"

I invite you to stop and take a break now. I make the same invitation to you that Jesus gave His disciples, "*Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest.*" We are in a place that has been sanctified. It has been set apart as a holy place, a place where we get to come and commune with God, the Creator of the universe. It is a place not unlike Moses' tent of meeting where he and God met face to face and spoke to one another as friends. It is a place where we can find rest, even for a short time from the burdens of life.

²⁸ "Come to Me, all ^[2] who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls." (Matthew 11)

I have purposely kept this sermon short. I want to have time to minister to any who wants prayer. If you are using the bulletin on the internet, or reading the mailed bulletin at home – stop, take a deep breath as Rev. Tom would say, and take time to talk to the Lord Who is listening to your praise, worship, and prayers. Talk to Him as you would a friend. When you are done, continue with the service.

Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. (Psalm 100:3)

Reread Psalm 23. Praise God for His everlasting love for you, and for His gifts to you. Amen
