SERMON

**“Rubrics and Algorithms”
Mark 7:1-8**

Rubrics and algorithms do not a relationship make.

Can you imagine using a rubric or following an algorithm on your honeymoon? This is what you have to do to earn an A, B, C, D, or F. Your grade will be based on your performance. Can you hear the song in the background, “What’s love got to do with it?”

Or using an algorithm, first you carry her over the threshold. Next you kiss her. If she responds to this in a positive manner you do this. If she does not respond to your kiss then you proceed to this other option. Laughable. Ridiculous. Absurd! Yuck!!!

How about using a rubric or an algorithm to choose your lifelong mate? Or how about using one of these to raise your children, love God, yourself, or others?

We laugh at these examples and yet this is exactly what the Pharisees and the Saducees were doing in the presence of Jesus. Unfortunately, many of us still use these today in forging or grading our relationship with God. We think in binary or dualistic terms. We divide life into good or bad, good or evil, black or white, up or down, this or that.

Here in this passage, Mark tells us the Pharisees did not eat unless they gave their hands a ceremonial washing. A rubric to keep score and an algorithm to lead them to their next decision. No love, joy, or peace here. Merely a code to follow, to grade and to gage behavior. Their thinking was, “I follow them and you do not, therefore I am better than you. I please God by following these rules. Since you do not follow them, God does not like you nor is he pleased with you.”

They held on to the traditions of the elders. They held on to the measuring stick to grade and gage behaviors. Never giving a second thought to intent, attitude, or motive. It was merely a blind obedience to a boatload of rules and regulations. Apparently, in their eyes, having earth, dust, or dirt on their hands while eating was displeasing to God. Jesus calls them on the carpet by using Isaiah’s words against them, “These people, (these rubric and algorithm following people) honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.” Meaning, their honoring of God was hollow and empty. There was no base nor substance to this kind of honor. Their heart, intention/motive/attitude was not in it. Futhermore, Jesus quotes, “They worship me in vain; (their recognition of me is hollow, empty, baseless), their teachings are merely

human rules." There is no Godly merit in their actions nor are they recognized, sanctioned, nor established by God. Merely Human. Of the earth. Temporal. Nothing but dust blown away by the wind!

Can you see that these terms of behaviors and beliefs are derived from the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil? It is a bifurcated tree. It has one root system with two branches. One branch is good, the other is evil yet they share the same root, death. It is a binary or dualistic system, giving knowledge of good and evil leading to death, to a separation from God Almighty who is the True Source, the True "Root" System. Life!

Binary thinking leads to winners and losers, us against them, we are right and they are wrong, we are in and they are out, eventually leading to separation and death.

This Tree of Knowledge of good and evil has a yes and a no. We choose. It is a tree that feeds on relativity where absolutes do not exist. Like the people in Judges, "we all do what is good in our own eyes." Binary and dualistic thinking is diametrically opposed to the Tree of Life. Here, at this tree, God chooses for us. He chooses "yes!" for us who are in Christ. It is the "yes" of relationship. There is no rubric or algorithm here. It is fluid, organic, and alive. An active sharing between two individuals in community.

There is only one way to relate to God in order to have a living, vibrant, and eternal relationship with him and that is through Love personified in Jesus Christ, who is God's "YES" for us. His Spirit in us is the Spirit which allows us to love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength and to love our neighbor as ourselves. This is the Tree of Life, Jesus Christ.

As, Galatians 5 reminds us, there is no law (no rubric or algorithm) against the fruit of the Holy Spirit which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Remember, rubrics and algorithms do not a relationship make. But Love does!

To God be the glory now and forever, amen.
