SERMON "In keeping with the word of the Lord" Dr. Carlos Baladez 1 Kings 17:16

Don't you just love stories? They are engaging. They inform, entertain, encourage, and persuade all at the same time. Here before us we have just one of those stories. And like all good stories it stands the test of time. Imagine yourself in the presence of God per his invitation and you sitting at his feet as his huge robe and train of glory touches your feet. You feel the warmth of his heart emanating from him and warming your face and heart. Then he starts. "Once upon a time in a land far, far away called Rocky Region, there lived a man. Yes, a man whose name meant, 'my God is Jehovah.' This man was my mouthpiece. I not only spoke to him but I spoke through him. What I whispered in his ear he would echo out loud for all to hear. You see in the past, during the time of Moses and the Great Exodus, I spoke directly to my people from the top of a mountain. But, they were too afraid and asked that I no longer speak to them in such manner. Therefore I started to speak to them through chosen men, in this case Elijah."

As you read the rest of the story in 1 Kings 17:1-16 you see the faithfulness of the Word of God spoken through his Prophet Elijah. The story tells of a wicked king. It also details a draught. The Prophet is given survival instructions and sustenance to live on.

Because of the lack of rain, he needs to move on from his hiding place. Again, he moves on at the Word of the Lord. This time the Lord spoke to a widow woman to provide for the Prophet. When the Prophet arrives he takes notice of the woman and asks her for some food. She reports that she has only enough oil and flour to make one cake for her and her son. They will eat this as their last meal and then die. The Prophet, instead of panicking, remembers the Faithful Word of the Lord and tells her to first make him a cake and then make one for her and her son. She trusts and obeys, no doubt recalling the instructions the Lord previously had given her before the Prophet's arrival. Yes, the instructions to feed him. The Prophet told her that as long as the rain was held back by the word he had spoken, she and her household would not lack. And it happened just as he had said, "in keeping with the word of the Lord!"

This story engages with the familiar phrase, "then the word of the Lord came..." because you know when the word of the Lord comes, action and drama are not far behind.

It also informs. It lets us know that God has enemies and friends. His enemies oppose his truth, his love, his Grace, and his plans to bless.

His friends, on the other hand, facilitate his truth. They seek it out and allow his truth to be lived out through them. His friends embrace the love of God, for themselves, for

others, for God's creation, and ultimately for God himself. His friends live by grace in faith with God and his Word and promote his plans to bless the nations - obeying his word as a result and a by-product of this great love.

It also entertains us - where in the world is the widow woman supposed to draw water from in a drought? Even the rivers are running dry? The irony of the Prophet's request! God, after all, had only directed the widow woman to supply Elijah with food. No word mentioned of any water. Really, Elijah? By the way, the text does not address this request.

The story encourages us to trust God and persuades us to say, "Yes, Lord" to God. In trustful and loving obedience we reap God's blessings even in the midst of scarcity. God's word is as faithful in your story as it is in the story of Elijah. It's not that we want to be like Elijah, it's that we have and worship the same God as Elijah! He provided for him. God provides for us too. Trust him to do as much.

God has given us a lifetime of promises in his beloved, Jesus Christ. "For God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ." (Eph. 1:3) Do you see it? As it has been spoken so now let it be!

God continues to write his story weaving it together through the lives of his friends, the ones who have responded in the affirmative to his "come." In Keeping with the Word of the Lord there is GREAT BLESSING!

Thank be to God. To him be all the Glory and Praise. Amen
