SERMON

**"The People Who Know Their God"
Daniel 11:32**

Dr. Carlos Baladez

"It was the best of times, it was the worst of times, it was the age of wisdom, it was the age of foolishness, it was the epoch of belief, it was the epoch of incredulity, it was the season of light, it was the season of darkness, it was the spring of hope, it was the winter of despair" is the first line in the Charles Dickens novel, *A Tale of Two Cities*.

It sounds like it could be a first line to the events we are experiencing on a global level. We have social unrest, narco-traffickers fighting turf wars, human trafficking preying on the innocent, poor and defenseless, political nightmares with half-truths, high level politicians spewing vitriolic attacks against whole groups of peoples, an opioid crises, economic upheavals, Co-vid 19 and YET there are babies being born, first time mothers and fathers, grandparents, uncles and cousins. Weddings too abound. Excitement of another birthday, wedding anniversary, or of beating cancer and other life threatening diseases. Sweet and sour experiences abound surrounding us every day, and yet there is hope, faith and love. The greatest of these being love.

In the passage we are looking at today, you have a glimmer of hope, a ray of sunshine, a golden nugget planted deep within the dirt. Looking at the preceding verses from our central verse this morning, you can see that the enemies of God are out in force. Noticing the events following our central verse you see more of the same. There is war between the kings of the North and the South eventually turning against the people of the covenant and rewarding those who forsake the holy covenant. And here in the middle of this chaos, in the midst of this fear and betrayal stand those who are faithful to the covenant. And these faithful ones are the people who know their God, and because they know their God, they firmly resist the enemies of God. Another translation reads, "But the people who know their God shall be strong, and carry out great exploits."
