## SERMON

#### "Elohim, GOD" Deuteronomy 10:17

Looking back, I can remember how in vogue it was to have a "how to" for everything Christian. There were programs, curriculums, training sessions, and seminars on "How to Pray," on "How to evangelize and share your faith," also on, "How to share the gospel in four easy steps." If you can believe it, there were even charts showing you all you ever wanted to know about the "end times" with timelines and precise sequence of events.

So, here I am today left with a bunch of outdated curriculums. Outmoded 1,2,3 easy steps books to \_\_\_\_ (you fill in the Christian blank). I also have past relics of tried and failed church growth textbooks which left many feeling frustrated, disappointed, and discouraged. We were left with feelings knowing we had been led short by those we trusted most. I don't believe it was intentional, yet intentional or not the results were the same, emptiness!

And then, as if by magic, 40 years later, I stumbled across a tiny piece of scripture in Daniel chapter 11. In the second half of the thirty-second verse, in the middle of adversity, there it is in print; "but the people who know their God will be strong and do exploits" (KJV).

The crux to having faith, prayer, church growth, and even knowing about the end times is based on "Knowing God." Yes, knowing God is the key to life, to living, to making a life, and to being alive! Knowing God as Love allows you and me to experience Love in its purest essence. Knowing God as Joy gives us the greatest pleasure. And knowing God as super over-the-top provider, overflowing all boundaries compels us forward to share with others and invite them into this glorious relationship available to all.

Let's look at today's verse and the name of God we will focus on this morning, Elohim. Deuteronomy 10:17 states, "For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality and accepts no bribes." The English term "God/gods" translates the Hebrew term "Elohim." In this verse, we are informed that Elohim is above all other gods and is Lord of all other lords. He is great, mighty and awesome. His character is to be just as he is not partial and cannot be bought with bribes.

Yet, this is not the first time we encounter this term, Elohim. The name first appears in Genesis 1-2. Here, in Genesis, the creator combines two of his names, YHWH which we saw 2 weeks ago with Elohim. YHWH is the name he uses when entering into covenant. Some theologians state the first covenant YHWH Elohim made with humankind was the Edenic covenant. In this covenant, God promises Adam life and blessings conditioned upon Adam's obedience to not to eat of the fruit of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. Adam fails. Elohim, in turn, does not. Instead, he provides a unilateral unconditional covenant which is not dependent upon human ability but on God's merciful character. Elohim himself will fulfill this covenant on behalf of his creatures and creation. All by himself!

Through a mindful reading of Gen 1-2 we see that Elohim was before time began. We take notice that he creates. He creates by speaking and by running his hand through dust to create man. He evaluates his own creation and declares it not only good but

very good. He speaks with his creation. He seeks out companionship. Just look at all the actions verbs attributed to YHWH Elohim. YHWH Elohim speaks, sees, separates, calls, makes, gathers, sets, allows, blesses, gives, forms, breathes, plants, takes and places, instructs, evaluates, causes, and fashions.

Did you take notice of the kinds of verbs attributed to God? Both action verbs and state of being verbs? As you take time to behold, you will see a beautiful and wonderful collage of Elohim form right before your eyes.

This, in part is knowing Elohim. Your God. This intimate, personal kind of "knowing," gives you strength to be strong and do exploits.

This kind of knowing gives you light and sight to see and speak, testify, and share the eternally Good News. We are loved and we are valued by God, by Elohim himself nonetheless!

Knowing Elohim personally, individually and in community is the essence, heart, and core to church growth, to evangelism, discipleship, faith, prayer, love, hope, peace and much, much more. Knowing God, leads to experiencing his heart, mind and acts. This experience of him leads to us to being endowed with his knowledge, wisdom, and understanding knowing that he is the source of all good things.

Elohim acts. Notice the action verbs in the verses that follow today's verse: "He <u>defends</u> the cause of the fatherless and the widow, and <u>loves</u> the foreigner residing among you, <u>giving</u> them food and clothing.

Knowing God causes us to act too. Look at the action verbs assigned to us: "And you are to <u>love</u> those who are foreigners, for you yourselves were foreigners in Egypt. <u>Fear</u> the Lord your God and <u>serve</u> him. <u>Hold fast</u> to him and <u>take your oaths</u> in his name. He is the one you <u>praise</u>; he is your God, who performed for you those great and awesome wonders you <u>saw</u> with your own eyes. Your ancestors who went down into Egypt were seventy in all, and now the Lord your God has made you as numerous as the stars in the sky."

Remember when you fell in love? You did not take a curriculum, or a seminar, or a class on how to fall in love. No, you saw, you liked what you saw, and courage swelled up within your heart and you went over to speak with the subject of your love. You took time to know the individual. And from there love led you. You then experienced a heart to heart encounter. As you came to know your mate you started to share the good news with others. You even went public and invited guests to the wedding.

When we know Elohim, we do the same.

Therefore, to know Elohim is to love God, is to serve him bringing others to know him, to love him, and to serve him so that they in turn will do the same for others and on and on it goes till he returns in "the end times!" Glory be to God.

Thanks be to God, now and forevermore, amen.
