# SERMON "Rachum Ve-Chanun, Merciful and Gracious" Dr. Carlos Baladez Exodus 34:6

"And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness,"

Our morning's text occurs shortly after the golden calf crisis where the people of God became weary of waiting for Moses to return from atop Mount Sinai. After all, Moses was gone for some time. So, they asked Aaron to make them an image of God to worship and to lead them. Aaron acquiesced to their request.

God sends Moses down to see what was happening. Moses was outraged! He broke the tablets upon which God had just written with his finger the 10 commandments. Moses then took the calf the people had made and burned it in the fire; then he ground it to powder, scattered it on the water, and made the Israelites drink it. Moses then intercedes for the people before God. The LORD assures Moses and lets him know that he will go with him and give him rest. Now Moses wants the LORD to show him his glory.

What happens next is remarkable.

The LORD invites Moses to present himself on top of the mountain once more. Then the LORD does something most beautiful and awe-inspiring.

Thus early in the morning, (a new day, a new beginning):

The Lord came down (in a cloud).

The Lord stood there (with Moses).

The Lord proclaimed (his own name).

As He passed IN FRONT of Moses:

Proclaiming, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate (merciful) and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness,"

We can count on God to act according to his nature. Today's name of God reveals our creator to be gracious. He is gracious to you and to your descendants up to the 1000th generation. This is a poetic way of saying, God is gracious forever!

This text also reveals our creator as merciful or full of mercy. Recall the Psalmist tells us that "the mercies of our God are new every morning."

Allow me to be so bold as to say to you this morning that our Creator is the same yesterday, today, and forever. He accepts you and makes a way for you to return to him even after the most atrocious sin against him. He comes down to meet you in a cloud. He comes down to your level and meets you in mystery, in places, and in times when you least expect him. He stands there with YOU! He knows that with him, all things are possible. He proclaims, and proclaims, and proclaims his name before you until you believe it in your heart, for He is full of faith and compassion towards you. He knows that he never fails.

As he invited Moses to come up to meet him on the mountain, he too invites us to leave our depression below. To cast our anxieties aside. To throw our worries upon him BECAUSE he cares for you and for me.

God revealed himself to Moses as Merciful and Gracious at the giving of the law. May I suggest that this was intentional on God's part? He knew we would not be able to ever keep the law, much less fulfill it. Therefore, he provided himself as Merciful and Gracious on our behalf.

You see, God continues to be Merciful and Gracious to us every morning. Great is his faithfulness towards us!

I urge you to surrender to God believe. Trust God to do the right thing for you at the right time and in the right way. Fear not, for the LORD your God is gracious and faithful and is with you wherever you go. Amen!

To God be the glory forever, amen.

In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."


