SERMON

"*Rab-Koach, Mighty Power*" Dr. Carlos Baladez 1 Chronicles 29:11-12

"Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all. Wealth and honor come from you; you are the ruler of all things. In your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all."

Since the beginning the power of God has been self-evident. A look at creation immediately raises these questions, "Who made all this? How did it all come about? How did we get here?" The Genesis account addresses these questions. It must have been some power to get all of this in order.

By the power in God's Word, the darkness is pushed back while the light is called forth.

By the power of his Word all the other things in the next 6 days are created.

The only exception to this is us. He creates us humans not by the power of his Word but by his very own hand working in the dust. Then gave us life by the breath of his Spirit.

Moving forward a few thousand years, we have another display of God's power in the Exodus account. Here, God delivers one nation from another without any traditional weapons of war. Instead, he uses the abundance of his creation. Blood, gnats, hail, and finally, death.

Advancing the timeline another thousand years, God once again put his power in full display, this time for people to see in the incarnation of himself in his son Christ Jesus. Words of powerful wisdom were heard. In John 7:46 the guards are quoted as saying "No one ever spoke this way this man does." God incarnate, in Jesus, reveals power over creation as witnessed at a wedding of all places, where water is turned to wine because a celebration needed to continue. The power of God is revealed as the sick were healed, the demonic were set free, and finally death and the grave were defeated at the resurrection.

Yet, possibly, the greatest display of God's power is yet to be seen. All of creation is waiting for the children of God to be revealed. It is in this display of power where all creation will be set free from frustration. Until this very day, all of creation groans to

see sin and its ugly effects banished from the face of the earth. And this future display of power has already started; giving us a peek of what is to come. This is because Christ Jesus has ushered in the kingdom of God and it is now within us awaiting its full expression in love. At long last, love will rule all of creation, including stubborn and obstinate humankind. On that day all darkness in all its form will be put to rest and light will shine towards us, within us, and out from us forever, reflecting the true source of all light, God. Once again we will see, as in the beginning God created the heavens and the earth, God in the end will recreate all of creation, including the new man, the new woman, the new earth, and the new stars, with a new people of God displaying the glorious image of the resurrected Christ who is our hope of glory. For our God is Mighty in Power.

To God be the glory now and forever, amen!
