SERMON "Melek Yahweh Tsabaot, King LORD of Hosts" Dr. Carlos Baladez Isaiah 6:3, 5

And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." ... "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." (NIV)

Do you ever fear? Doubt? Or experience Unbelief? What do you do in such cases? Where do you turn? What is your attitude towards these enemies of the Lord when you encounter them?

It has been said that the command of God to humankind, "Do not fear," is encountered 365x in scripture. Why is this particular command and not "Love God" or "Love you neighbor as yourself" repeated so often?

Maybe it goes back to the Garden of Eden. Perhaps fear is primordial? After all, when the first humans fail to trust God, the first emotion they felt was fear. After their eyes "were opened," they covered their nakedness and hid from the Creator of All, who is LOVE.

Why do we doubt? Perhaps the answer again lies in the beginning, in Genesis 3. The serpent was the very first one in scripture to pose a question. And not just any question, but a question with a malicious intent, a seed of sorts, to plant doubt, "Hath God said...?" You can almost hear its hissing voice.

And unbelief? Once more, we can turn to the opening chapters of scripture and listen to the voice of God asking the male creation, "Have you eaten from the tree that I commanded you not to eat from?" The man's response could have been a confession of repentance but instead, he answers with a declaration of blame. No acceptance of personal responsibility, only blame of the others. In this case, blaming the woman and God.

By the time Isaiah came on the scene, about 2000 years after Genesis 1, the people of Israel were all too familiar with these three enemies of God. As a result, they found themselves servicing foreign kings, false gods, and were soon to be in exile. These false gods were made by human hands out of gold, silver, and wood. After using half of the log to make false gods to worship, the craftsmen would use the other half of the log to

make fires to keep them warm. Their eyes were sealed to the absurdity. Lost in the darkness of their hearts, minds, and souls. Wasting their strength in pits of despair.

Under these conditions, we meet Isaiah. Like Noah, Isaiah too found grace in the eyes of the Lord. Isaiah's eyes were opened to see. To see the majesty of the Creator of the Universe. To see the Lord of the Hosts of heaven, seated high upon his throne. Is it any wonder Isaiah cried out, "Woe is me!?"

People become sick from the effects of fear suffering from anxiety, panic attacks, and irrational phobias. People are engulfed by a pontificating spirit when under the influence of doubt and become cynical when drunk with unbelief. Our minds become mush while our hearts become hard as stone. Mushy minds and stony hearts - not a winning combination. These individuals start making statements like, "There is no God," or "God is dead!" God calls these individuals, "FOOLS!"

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." At the sound of their voices, the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. "Woe to me!" Cried, Isaiah. He confessed, "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." (Isaiah 6, NIV)

In the midst of mourning, death, and defeat, for it was in the year that King Uzziah died, here in this time, and in this space, The Lord of Hosts shows up and opens Isaiah's eyes to see. Not like Adam's eyes were "Opened," as a result of distrust, but as an act of sheer grace on behalf of God's part towards Isaiah.

Fear, doubt, and unbelief are confronted, exposed, and slain by the Lord of Hosts! God shows up and shows off. Sight, true sight is restored to Isaiah as he sees with his own eyes the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. He is also given true sight to see in the true Light, that above the Lord were seraphim, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying." Simultaneously, Isaiah's ears are open and he hears these angelic beings calling to one another saying: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." Isaiah is able to feel in this holy presence. At the sound of these angelic voices,' the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke."

Isaiah knew and confessed what Adam failed to confess, Isaiah cried out, "Woe to me!" "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the Lord Almighty." As a result of this confession, one of the seraphim flew to Isaiah with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it, the seraphim touched Isaiah's mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for."

It is at this point that Isaiah's ears are opened to hear not only the voices of the angelic beings but the very holy voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And Isaiah responds without any fear, doubt, or unbelief, saying, "Here am I. Send me!"

This past Thursday, our church calendar recognized and celebrated the Ascension of the Lord. Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again. Christ, our loving Lord and Savior is seated at the right hand of the Father on High, interceding on our behalf. Christ had conquered death and the grave. He died to sin once and for all and now lives unto God forever. Never to die again. In Christ, we live and move and have our being, forever. In him we are secured, loved, adored, protected, healed, made whole, assured, and so much more.

Christ is risen. Christ has triumphed. Therefore let us turn to him, focus on him, trust him, and run to him knowing we will encounter the living Lord of Hosts. The Lord with a myriad of angels at his bidding. Angels who have been assigned to protect us, to be our partners in ministry as we accept the love of the Lord for us and for one another sharing it with all we encounter. By the witness of the Resurrection, we are assured of fear, doubt, and unbelief's defeat forevermore!

Are you being harassed by the enemies of the Lord? Stand firm in the faith of your Lord, by his grace. In his strength, his power, and his victory, submit to the Lord, resist the devil and he will flee. Remind the devil and his minions of their defeat. Feed doubt its own doubt, feed fear its own fear, and unbelief its own unbelief. And you, feast yourself in the Word of the Lord. Gorge yourself with his truth and love. In Christ, he has made us more than conquerors. Fear not! For the Lord of Host is with us all. Always. Hallelujah!

To God be all the glory now and forever, amen.
