SERMON "Elohey Tehillati, God of My Praise" Dr. Carlos Baladez Deuteronomy 10:21

"He is your praise. He is your God, who has done for you these great and terrifying things that your eyes have seen." (NIV)

God of our praise. Does this name mean that God is the ruler of our praise or the object of our praise? Does God directs our praise or does he merely receive our praise? Or both?

God, being who he is, influences our praise and receives our praise. He is both the Alpha and the Omega. His nature determines and frames our praise. Think of it like this. The temperature of a steel plate determines or influences our response. A steel plate at room temperature is not going to elicit the same reaction or response from us as if that same plate was piping hot or freezing cold.

Likewise, God. His love saturates our natures and crafts within us an overwhelming response which we call praise. Let's look at some biblical examples. Abraham left his ancestral home and set off to look for a city whose foundation was God. Moses, took off his shoes and dared not look at the presence of God shining in the burning bush. David took off his clothes and danced wildly bringing he Ark of the Covenant back home to its rightful place.

Listen to Hannah's praise after being taunted for being barren and then given the promise that she would bear a son. "My heart rejoices in the Lord; My horn is exalted in the Lord, My mouth speaks boldly against my enemies, Because I rejoice in Your salvation. There is no one holy like the Lord, Indeed, there is no one besides You, Nor is there any rock like our God. Do not go on boasting so very proudly, Do not let arrogance come out of your mouth; For the Lord is a God of knowledge, And with Him actions are weighed. The bows of the mighty are broken to pieces, But those who have stumbled strap on strength. Those who were full hire themselves out for bread, But those who were hungry cease to be hungry. Even the infertile woman gives birth to seven, But she who has many children languishes. The Lord puts to death and makes alive; He brings down to Sheol and brings up. The Lord makes poor and rich; He humbles, He also exalts. He raises the poor from the dust, He lifts the needy from the garbage heap To seat them with nobles, And He gives them a seat of honor as an inheritance; For the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, And He set the world on them.

He watches over the feet of His godly ones, But the wicked ones are silenced in darkness; For not by might shall a person prevail. Those who contend with the Lord will be terrified; Against them He will thunder in the heavens, The Lord will judge the ends of the earth; And He will give strength to His king, And will exalt the horn of His anointed." I Samuel 2:1-10, (NIV)

Elizabeth in turn praises God in the following manner while she was caring her son, John the Baptizer, in her old age, "When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. And she cried out with a loud voice and said, "Blessed *are* you among women, and blessed *is* the fruit of your womb! And ^[b]how has it happened to me that the mother of my Lord would come to me? For behold, when the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby leaped in my womb for joy. And blessed *is* she who ^[c]believed that there would be a fulfillment of what had been spoken to her ^[d]by the Lord." Luke 1:41-45 NIV

While Mary, the mother of Jesus, in her Magnificant express her Praise to God in the following way, "My soul exalts the Lord, And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. For He has had regard for the humble state of His bond-servant; For behold, from now *on* all generations will call me blessed. For the Mighty One has done great things for me; And holy is His name. And His mercy is to generation after generation Toward those who fear Him. He has done mighty deeds with His arm; He has scattered *those who were* proud in the thoughts of their hearts. He has brought down rulers from *their* thrones, And has exalted those who were humble. He has filled the hungry with good things, And sent the rich away empty-handed. He has given help to His servant Israel, In remembrance of His mercy, Just as He spoke to our fathers, To Abraham and his descendants forever." Luke 1:46-55

Simeon's praise comes towards the end of his life when holding Jesus in his very own hands. Scripture reports the following, "There was a man in Jerusalem by the name of Simeon. He was a good man and very religious. He was looking for the time when the Jewish nation would be saved. The Holy Spirit was on him. The Holy Spirit made it known to Simeon that he would not die before he had seen God's Chosen One. He came to the house of God being led by the Holy Spirit. The parents took Jesus to the house of God. They came to do what the Law said must be done. Then Simeon took Jesus in his arms. He gave honor to Him and thanked God, saying, "Lord, now let me die in peace, as You have said. My eyes have seen the One Who will save men from the punishment of their sins. You have made Him ready in the sight of all nations. He will be a light to shine on the people who are not Jews. He will be the shining-greatness of Your people the Jews." Luke 2:25-32, NIV

We too are having our praises to God recorded in God's memory somewhere through song, prayer, word, and deed. We praise God with every heartbeat, with every breath we take, with every electrical impulse our cells produce. In him we are alive forevermore. May this be our prayer today, "Lord, open our mouths and our lips will praise you." Amen!
