SERMON "Avi, Father"
2 Corinthians 6:18

Dr. Carlos Baladez

Proverbs 5:15-23

And, "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." (NIV)

Keeping in mind our foundational verse for this series of messages, Daniel 11:32b in the KJV reads, "but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do exploits," the focus of God's name for today is Avi, which is Father.

Here are some quotes regarding earthly fathers. Some of these quotes may or may not remind up of your earthly father, depending on your own personal experience. Nevertheless, these quotes may remind you of your earthly father or they may be a wish of how you would like them to be or would have liked them to be.

- "It is a wise father that knows his own child." —William Shakespeare
- "One father is more than a hundred schoolmasters." —George Herbert
- "A father doesn't tell you that he loves you. He shows you." —Dimitri the Stoneheart
- "Fathers just have a way of putting everything together." —Erika Cosby
- "Behind every great daughter is a truly amazing father." —Unknown
- "To her, the name of father was another name for love." —Fanny Fern
- "No music is so pleasant to my ears as that word—father." —Lydia Maria Child
- "A father carries pictures where his money used to be." —Steve Martin
- "When my father didn't have my hand, he had my back." —Linda Poindexter
- "A father is someone you look up to no matter how tall you grow." —Unknown

 "The greatest mark of a father is how he treats his children when no one is looking." —Dan Pearce

The image of "father," may be tarnished or distorted if your father did not have the maturity level or a father who modeled for him what a father was and how a father acted. Unfortunately, these behaviors can become generational if a father in the line of secession does not break the pattern. But, happy are those children who do have a loving father who knew before having offspring that children are to be loved for the entire life of father and child. Sin, ignorance, arrogance, and blind spots, all can cause a lack of awareness where the father is not consciously aware of his behavior towards his children or simply has unresolved "daddy issues," of his own. He may or may not be aware that he is teaching his sons what kind of father to be or his daughters what kind of man to marry and have children of their own.

Are we to despair because our earthly fathers are not aware? Or are not transforming? Or do we see no hope for them or for us? Most certainly not. Because God comes into the picture to save this part of our lives too. He comes to restore the distorted image of father and one which we project upon him. He understands. He does not become upset or exasperated with you. No, instead he begins to show you the true picture of what a father is. Jesus points to our Heavenly Father throughout the gospels. Jesus, the sinless one, the one who does not lie, distort, or deceive assures us that God, our heavenly Father, Loves Us! He does not only love us, he loves us very much. He would rather die than live without us. Thankfully, he did just that in Jesus Christ, yet because he had no sin, death nor the grave could hold him. Jesus was raised to life to live forevermore, once again showing us that the love of God our Father is stronger than sin, death, and the grave.

Now, let's turn to today's passage where our central verse is found in the Word of God, and see a picture of our Heavenly Father.

It starts in verse 14 with some Fatherly advice:

"Do not be yoked together with unbelievers." This is reminding us that we have been washed clean with the blood of Jesus. We no longer belong to the forces of darkness. We are children of light, therefore join forces with other children of God while inviting

unbelievers to believe. Give them a reason to believe. Let Christ shine through your words, behavior, and choices.

Father then proceeds to ask some questions to consider and ponder the response:

For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common?

Or what fellowship can light have with darkness?

What harmony is there between Christ and Belial? Side note: Belial was used to personify wickedness and worthlessness* which later became personified as the devil in Christian texts of the New Testament. **

Or what does a believer have in common with an unbeliever?

What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols?

Now comes the rationale for the above questions. "For we are the temple of the living God." God dwells in us through his Holy Spirit. God is love, light, a consuming fire, and God is Spirit. This is Him who lives in us now!

Now, let's notice some of our Heavenly Father's promises which reflect his heart and his character:

Father continues with promises showing his desire for and towards us. Abba, Father states:

"I will live with them and ("will" too is implied here) walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people."

Abba calls out to us:

"Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." Abba's promise:
"I will be a Father to you,
and you will be my sons and daughters,
says the Lord Almighty."

This is the hope and acceptance that we all seek. We all seek a Father who loves us unconditionally. A Father who shows us how much he values us and cares for us.

Here is your challenge. Go go home and ask God to reveal himself as Father to you, personally. Write down your dialogue with him. Call upon him as Father. Tell him your story. He loves stories, and he loves you.

Now go, and allow him to rectify within you the image of Father and know his love for you. Alleluia!

To God be all the honor, glory, and praise for evermore. Amen.
