### SERMON "Yahweh Chelqi, The LORD My Portion" Dr. Carlos Baladez Psalm 73:25-26

"Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever." (NIV)

My father was born into of family of 11 surviving siblings. He was the youngest male and was a mama's boy.

As you can imagine, it took a ton of tortillas to feed a family this size. My grandmother would make a pile of them, for breakfast, and then again for lunch, and then again for dinner. Before each meal, she would set them out in the middle of the table. Once all were served and my grandfather sat at the table, all would start to eat. Every person at the table was given a portion, but the smart ones would take their first tortilla and place it under their plate and once all the tortillas were gone they would pull out the hidden one and have the last delicious bite.

During WW II, rations cards were given throughout Great Britain. Having a ration card did not guarantee all would be able to obtain their allotted rations as many time food would run out. Yet the government attempted to give all its citizens their allotted portion.

Today's passage reads as follows, "Whom have I in heaven but you? And earth has nothing I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever."

A portion is a share or part of the whole. The inheritance is distributed to the rightful recipients. When my parents died, I was made the excutor of the estate. I had the responsibility to divide the inheritance between my siblings and myself. This inheritance is still with us today. It allowed each one of us to have a dwelling and raise our respective families.

Today's passage asks a quesition, "Whom have I in heaven but you?" and the answer is God. Yes, Elohim the one true God. The ONE we saw in Genesis 1:1, the one who created all that is seen and unseen, out of nothing.

This is the one who we have in heaven and on earth. God is our strrength, our rock, our cliff of safety, and our delight. He is the one in whom we take great pleasure and are pleased to have.

The things of this earth, even the closest things and most cherished such as our bodies and our hearts will fail us. They will fail us because they are of this earth. They are made of dust and to dust they will return. But in Elohim, we find permanence, eternity, faithfulness, and everlasting joy. God is for ever and without end. With God there is no fear of running out or not being enough! All our needs and wants are met in and by him.

God, our inheritance, is our Comforter, Healer, Provider, Redeemer, Friend, Father, High Priest, Advocate, Helper, Counselor, Teacher, Guide, and so much more. We can call God any of these names and he wil respond to us in love, mercy, and grace. He will respond because He is Faithful.

Now what do we do with such glorious good news? Receive them as they are given, freely. Believe the Good News for they are true. And share them with others because they are too good and too big to keep to ourselves. This is the Father's will for us. To be loved and to love. This is our portion.

Tell HIS Story! Tell it well. Tell it often, and tell it faithfully in Grace and in Love.

To God be all the honor, glory, and praise. Now and forevermore, amen.
