SERMON "Yahweh Tsidkenu, The Lord Our Righteousness" Dr. Carlos Baladez Jeremiah 23:6

"In his days Judah will be saved and Israel will live in safety. This is the name by which he will be called: The Lord Our Righteous Savior."

Bleak and dark seems to be appropriate words to describe the condition of our nation our world, and its political climate. It seems that every time we wake up we hear of another mass shooting. Senseless killings because someone decided on taking innocent life as if this was the solution to our problems. Long wolves shoot people because they have a different shade of skin. Killing others because they were born women. People are killed because shady dealers do not want their under-the-table deals to come to light. How long will it take us as a human species to determine the senselessness of war? When will we as humans stop exploiting the land, sky, and ocean?

What makes matters worse is the fact that religious leaders cannot agree on the meaning of sacred texts. You have the three monotheistic religions, Christians, Muslims, and Jews stating their own truths, not to mention the other thousands of other religions around the world.

People go around wishing for the "good ole days," not knowing that there have never been good ole days for everybody. The good ole days were only good for the oppressors but not for the oppressed. They were good for the exploiters but not for the exploited. They were good for the movers and shakers but not for the moved and shaken.

Shortly after the beginning, things did not turn out well for Adam and Eve nor for their descendants. Cain kills Abel, then comes the flood, afterward our ancestors decide to reach heaven. As a result of this, their languages are confused. Afterward, God calls Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Their descendants spend 400 years as slaves in Egypt. Moses is sent to deliver them and then God establishes kings, prophets, and priests. They were responsible for leading, teaching, and interceding for the people of God. We come to the time of Jeremiah and these three institutions are failing, much like they are today. Our government leaders lie to us. Our prophets no longer proclaim the message of grace and truth, and our priests are violating their oaths.

Where O where can we place our trust and confidence? God invites us to look up to him. He invites us to call upon the name of Jesus for this is the name given among men by which we might be saved. God calls us to rest for our intensive and weary labors and he will give us rest. The labor he speaks of is not manual labor but the labor of us trying to do things right in our own strength. God calls us to trust in him and in the work of his labor. The labor was completed by Jesus at the cross. We are invited to believe, trust, and receive forgiveness, righteousness, and goodness by faith. The New Life Version translates Jeremiah 23:6 as, "In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will be safe. And this is the name He will be called by: 'The Lord Who makes us right and good."

Yes, it is not the "good ole days" that we are too long for but we are to look towards the "good new day." The day the Good Lord promises us to make all things right. On that day we will give witness to our God as "The Lord Who makes us right and good."

Therefore, read the paper. Be informed. And let the news inspire you to look up and to look forward to that day. As we celebrate the first Sunday of Advent, we celebrate the first coming of our Lord. Let us hold fast to our confession, Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again!

To God be the glory, honor, and praise forevermore. Amen.
